30 Days of Prayer

Prayer Guide One

30 Days of Prayer is a time for us as a church family to begin our year with vigorous prayer, asking God to mature us spiritually, to lead us in ministry, and to empower our witness.

Thursday, January 29 Day 1
Call to Me and I will answer you and tell you great and wondrous things you do not know.

Jeremiah 33:3

Is your life big enough? Give some thought today to what God could do in your life — and through your life — through your prayers.

Friday, January 30 Day 2
Devote yourselves to prayer; stay alert in it with thanksgiving.

Colossians 4:2

Are you living a life of prayer? Could you say that you are devoted to prayer? If you aren't presently using a prayer list or notebook, begin using one today! Make a trip to the store if you need to. Ask God what you need to start putting on your prayer list.

Saturday, January 31 Day 3
Even before they call, I will answer; while they are still speaking, I will hear.

Isaiah 65:24

Prayer is not forcing a reluctant God,

but laying hold of His willingness to bless us. Find out where God is already moving and move with Him.

Sunday, February 1 Day 4
PrayerWalk: Today at 3 PM

Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God concerning them is for their salvation!

Romans 10:1

Participate in today's PrayerWalk.

Monday, February 2 Day 5
Now if any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives to all generously and without criticizing, and it will be given to him.

James 1:5

What did you notice in the PrayerWalk yesterday. Make a list of spiritual needs that you sensed, and pray about them for the rest of 30 Days of Prayer.

☐ **Tuesday, February 3 Day 6**

Take words of repentance with you and return to the Lord. Say to Him: "Forgive all our sin and accept what is good, so that we may repay You with praise from our lips." Hosea 14:2

Are you on praying ground—or is there sin you are holding onto? If not, repent and take corrective action. Ask God to help you.

☐ **Wednesday, February Day 7**

I am not praying that You take them out of the world but that You protect them from the evil one. They are not of the world, as I am not of the world.

John 17:15-16

Here, Jesus prayed for His disciples and all future Christians. His motive was not to make us "other worldly," but to make us some earthly good. Yet, sometimes, the devil attacks us, engaging us in "spiritual warfare." Can you relate to that? Pray for God's protection.

☐ **Thursday, February 5 Day 8**

Whatever you ask in My name, I will do it so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. Jn 14:13

Are you motivated by seeing God receive glory? That is the purpose for which we were created—to enjoy Him and glorify Him forever. Do your prayers reflect that concern? Ask God to bring glory to Himself through you.

☐ **Friday, February 6 Day 9**

If you remain in Me and My words remain in you, ask whatever you want and it will be done for you. John 15:7

Are you having meaningful devotional times where the Bible speaks to you? Do you find yourself claiming promises from the Bible? Start marking verses in your Bible study and pray about what you read. Do that today.

☐ **Saturday, February 7 Day 10**

Until now you have asked for nothing in My name. Ask and you will receive, that your joy may be complete. John 16:24

There is nothing that gives us more joy than seeing our prayers answered! Yet, the only reason God can answer our prayers is because of Jesus. When we pray in His name, it is like charging our request to His account — as if Jesus had given us His credit card. What would you dare to pray for on Jesus' account that you wouldn't dare charge to yours? Pray for that!

☐ **Sunday, February 8 Day 11**

And if you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer. Matthew 21:22

Do you sometimes pray and forget what you asked for? Would you be surprised to see an answer to your pray some of your prayers? If you aren't looking expectantly for the answer, then you aren't praying in faith.

Ask God to give you something so big to pray for that only God can do it — and then believe Him to do it.

☐ **Monday, February 9 Day 12**

Be sober! Be on the alert! Your adversary the Devil is prowling around like a roaring lion, looking for anyone he can devour.

1st Peter 5:8

We have all seen the devil get into a church and do great damage to their fellowship and testimony. We should never be so proud as to think that it couldn't happen here. Instead, be alert to the danger and pray for God's protection. Today, pray for First Baptist in this way.

☐ **Tuesday, February 10 Day 13**

With every prayer and request, pray at all times in the Spirit, and stay alert in this, with all perseverance and intercession for all the saints. Ephesians 6:18

Are you praying for other Christians? Are their names on your prayer list? Do you pray for their spiritually needs, as well as their physical needs?

☐ **Wednesday, Feb. 11 Day 14**

Pray also for me, that the message may be given to me when I open my mouth to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel. Ephesians 6:19

Ask God to give you the words and boldness to share the good news of Jesus with others. Then, be alert to opportunities to share your faith.

☐ **Thursday, February 12 Day 15**

In the same way the Spirit also joins to help in our weakness, because we do not know what to pray for as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with unspoken groanings.

Romans 8:26

Do you rely on the Holy Spirit as you pray? As you pray today, ask the Holy Spirit to help you. Know that He will help you in ways that you cannot hear.

☐ **Friday, February 13 Day 15**

You will search for the Lord your God, and you will find Him when you seek Him with all your heart and all your soul.

Deuteronomy 4:29

When you pray, are you spending time alone with God? Or when you pray, are you just reading out your give-me list? Talk with God today without asking for anything.

☐ **Saturday, February 14 Day 16**

Therefore I want the men in every place to pray, lifting up holy hands without anger or argument. 1st Timothy 2:8

A powerful prayer life requires that we live holy lives and that we live in harmony in our relationships. Is anything hindering your prayer life today?
