- Our teachers are in the room before the first child arrives.
- The room is prepared for the lesson before the children arrive.
- Workers greet the children at eye-level at the door as they enter the class.
- The room is uncluttered. There is more space than equipment.
- The equipment and visuals are at the eye-level of the children.
- The Bible is in evidence in the room.
- The room is arranged by activities, rather than “chairs around tables.”
- There are men teaching in the department so every child can see what an adult Christian male looks like.
- We teach “one lesson at a time.” Visuals are on the theme of today’s lesson, not a bunch of old stuff cluttering the room and over-stimulating the preschoolers.
- The children can choose from several activities.
- Activities are of interest to preschoolers, having real flowers, goldfish, etc.
- Activities allow the preschoolers to be creative and to express themselves. Preschoolers are allowed to do their own work; crafts aren’t made by teachers for the children.
- Music is used... teachers sing, CD player, etc.
